

**OREGON REVISED STATUTES**

**TURN SIGNALS**

- \*816.310 Exemption from lighting equipment requirements.  
(3D) Antique motor vehicles that are maintained as a collector item & used for exhibition, parades, club activities, and similar uses, but not used primarily for transportation of persons or property.

**BLUE DOTS**

- \*816.080 Blue dot taillights.  
(8) On a motor vehicle that was manufactured before 1959, the taillight or the taillight assembly, if the taillight is combined with another light, may contain a blue or purple insert of not more than one inch in diameter.

**FENDERS**

- \*815.190 Exemptions from mudguard and fender requirements.  
(3) Antique motor vehicles are exempt from standard requirements if the vehicles are maintained as collector's items & used for exhibitions, parades, club activities & similar uses, but not used primarily for transportation of persons or property.

**ONE PLATE**

- \*803.525 Vehicle plates.  
Sec. 3 If a person has registered an antique vehicle or special interest vehicle prior to 1/1/02, and has received 2 registration plates, the person may display either one or both plates, but if only one plate is displayed, that plate must be displayed on the rear of the vehicle.

**WINDOW TINTING**

- \*815.221 Tinting; authorized and prohibited materials; certificate.  
(2) Tinting material may be applied to the side & rear windows of a motor vehicle if:  
(a) The tinting material has a light transmittance of 50% or more;  
(b) The tinting material has a light reflectance of 13% or less; and  
(c) The total light transmittance through the window with the tinting material applied is 35% or more.  
Tinting material that has a lower light transmittance or produces a lower total light transmittance than permitted in subsection (2) (a) & (c) of this section may be applied to the top six inches of a windshield. Tinting material may not be applied to any other portion of the windshield.  
...may be applied to all windows of a multipurpose passenger vehicle that are behind the driver. This subsection applies only to vehicles that are equipped with rearview mirrors on each side of the vehicle.  
Tinting material not permitted: Mirror finish; red, gold, yellow, amber, or black materials; liquid form.  
(7) Each person who installs window-tinting material in compliance with this section shall give the person who requested the installation a certificate.

**CLEARANCE**

- \*815.245 Violation of minimum clearance req. for passenger vehicles penalty.  
(2) A vehicle does not have clearance from the surface of the roadway required by this section if any portion of the vehicle, other than the wheels, has less clearance from the surface of a level roadway than the clearance between the roadway & the lowest portion of any rim of any wheel in contact with the roadway.

**FORMULA FOR CHECKING SPEEDOMETER ACCURACY**

**RPM X Tire Radius = X** or \_\_\_\_\_ MPH AT \_\_\_\_\_ RPM  
Ration X 168 = X  
Example: 2100 X 14.5 = 304.50 or 69.2 MPH at 2100 RPM with a 29" tire  
2.62 X 168 = 440.16
